RECREATIONAL ACCESS INFORMATION

ACCESS INFORMATION

Alsea Area:

- The South Toledo/1000 Line area is open to motorized access, along with the 1014 to Table Mtn, 1040, 1060, 1080 to 1040 junction and 3800 roads. Access is not allowed behind any areas posted with active operation signs.
- At all other gates in the Alsea area, non-motorized access is allowed behind gates that are NOT posted as Private Recreation Leased property.
- Weyerhaeuser property off Hayden and Haines County roads is closed to public entry.

Mid-Coast:

- The majority of Black Rock is a permit area. Please visit our website for additional information. Mill Creek is not within the Black Rock permit area and is open for non-motorized access during IFPL 1, 2,3, and closed at IFPL 4. Outside of fire season, Mill Creek will be open for motorized access. The Valsetz ML is open for thru public traffic during IFPL 1 and 2, and non-motorized during IFPL 3 and closed to all access during IFPL 4.
- North Toledo (North of Hwy 20): The majority of this area is under a new ODF&W Access and Habitat Agreement. The Gorge Mainline Road is open for motorized access during weekends during IFPL 1 & 2 and non-motorized access during weekdays, up to IFPL 3. Non-motorized access is allowed behind locked gates. See kiosks for a list of the designated access points. Follow all posted signs regarding the Travel Management Area restrictions and active harvest areas.
- Trask: Toll, Turner Creek, Murphy Camp Toll, Murphy Camp Flora, Baker Creek, White, Belt, Holiday and Vonn Road gates are open for motorized access. Turner Creek gate will be open thru December 31, 2020, all other gates will be closed after bull elk season.

Clackamas:

- Estacada/Hood River is a permit area. Please visit our website for additional information.
- Molalla is a permit area that is closed to all access due to fire salvage operations.
- Weyerhaeuser ownership located east of Hwy 35 in the Hood River area is open for motorized access.

Snow Peak:



- Snow Peak Permit Area: The Abiqua/Silver Falls portion of this permit area is closed to all
 access due to fire salvage operations. The Snow Peak ML gate in Linn County is the access point
 for permittees for this permit area.
- Areas outside the permit area, Detroit, Green Mtn, 7-Mile are closed to all access due to fire salvage operations.
- Thomas Creek/US Ply Main Line Gates are open for motorized access thru December 7, 2020.
 Non-motorized access is permitted behind the 10-mile gate on US Ply.

Springfield:

- Springfield Permit Area: This permit area is closed to all access due to fire salvage operations.
- There is no public access to Weyerhaeuser lands north of the Upper Calapooia County Road or to the Calapooia River. For current Calapooia road closures please refer to the Linn County website.
- Areas outside of our recreational permit/lease program are open for non-motorized access.

When on our timberlands...

- Access is only permitted 1½ hours before sunrise and closes 1½ hours after sunset.
- Stay clear of all active work areas, obey all signs and do not block gates when you park.
- ATV, ORVs, motorcycles or motor-assisted bicycles are NOT allowed.
- When motor vehicles are allowed, they must stay on improved rock roads only.
- Target shooting, trash dumping, camping, fires, and removal of firewood or any special forest products is NOT allowed.
- Firearms are only allowed for licensed hunters during State-regulated hunting seasons. Licensed hunters must obey all State hunting regulations.

SCATTERED LEASE TRACTS

We have scattered leased tracts located throughout the Willamette Valley Region. These tracts are posted "No Trespassing –Private Recreation Lease" and are closed to all entry unless you have a lease.
