RECREATIONAL ACCESS INFORMATION

ACCESS INFORMATION

Alsea Area:

- The South Toledo/1000 Line area is open to motorized access, along with the 1014 to Table Mtn, 1040, 1060, 1080 to 1040 junction and 3800 roads.
- Weyerhaeuser property off Hayden, Haines, and Honey Grove County Roads is closed to public entry.
- At all other gates in the Alsea Area, non-motorized access is allowed behind gates that are NOT posted as Private Recreation Leased property.
- Access is not allowed behind any areas posted with active operation signs.

Mid-Coast:

- Black Rock: Most of this area is a permit area. Please visit our website for additional information. Mill Creek and S-Line gates are part of an Access and Habitat area and are open for motorized access until the start of 2023 fire season. The Valsetz Mainline is open to motorized access until the start of 2023 fire season and then closed IFPL 3.
- North Toledo/Siletz (North of Hwy 20): The majority of this area is under an ODFW Access
 and Habitat Agreement. The Gorge Mainline Road is open for motorized access during
 weekends up to IFPL 2 and non-motorized access during weekdays up to IFPL 3. Non-motorized
 access is allowed behind locked gates up to IFPL 3. See gate kiosks and ODFW website for
 additional information. Follow all posted signs regarding the Travel Management Area
 restrictions and stay out of all active harvest areas.
- **Trask**: As of 10/24/22, the Toll, Turner Creek, Barney, Flora, Murphy Camp Toll, Murphy Camp Flora, Baker Creek, Elk Flat, White, Belt, Holiday and Vonn Road gates are open for motorized access thru 11/30/22, except for Turner Creek and Barney which stay open until 2023 Fire Season is in effect, IFPL 3.

Clackamas:

- **Estacada/Hood River** is a permit area. Please visit our website for additional information. Weyerhaeuser ownership located east of Hwy 35 is open for motorized access.
- Molalla is a permit area, please visit our website for additional information.

Snow Peak:

- Snow Peak is a permit area, please visit our website for additional information.
- Areas outside the permit area: As of 10/25/22, Thomas Creek/US Ply Main Line Gates are open for motorized access. Non-motorized access is permitted in the Detroit, Green Mtn, 7-Mile areas and behind the 10-mile gate on US Ply.



When access is permitted:

- Access is only permitted 1½ hours before sunrise and closes 1½ hours after sunset.
- Stay clear of all active work areas, obey all signs and do not block gates when you park.
- ATV, ORVs, motorcycles or motor-assisted bicycles are NOT allowed.
- When motor vehicles are allowed, they must stay on improved rock roads only.
- Target shooting, trash dumping, camping, fires, and removal of firewood or any special forest products is NOT allowed.

SCATTERED LEASE TRACTS

We have scattered leased tracts located throughout the Willamette Valley Region. These tracts are posted "No Trespassing –Private Recreation Lease" and are closed to all entry unless you have a lease.
