ERM Certification & Verification Services Incorporated ("ERM CVS") was engaged by Weyerhaeuser Company ("Weyerhaeuser") to provide limited assurance in relation to the Selected Information for 2025, set out below and presented in Weyerhaeuser's Carbon Record (the "Report") and in the 'Greenhouse Gas Emissions' data table on the Weyerhaeuser Data and GRI Index [website](#) ("the Website").

## ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY

**Scope of our assurance engagement** Whether the following Selected Information as indicated on page 5 of the Report, and on the [Website](#) as accessed on May 1, 2026 are fairly presented in the Report and on the Website, in all material respects, in accordance with the reporting criteria.

**Assurance standard and level of assurance** We performed a limited assurance engagement, in accordance with the International Standard on Assurance Engagements ISAE 3000 (Revised) 'Assurance Engagements other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information' issued by the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board.

The procedures performed in a limited assurance engagement vary in nature and timing from and are less in extent than for a reasonable assurance engagement and consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

**Respective responsibilities** Weyerhaeuser is responsible for preparing the Report and the Website and for the collection and presentation of the information within it, and for the designing, implementing and maintaining of internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Selected Information.

ERM CVS' responsibility is to provide a conclusion to Weyerhaeuser on the agreed assurance scope based on our engagement terms with Weyerhaeuser, the assurance activities performed and exercising our professional judgement.

## OUR CONCLUSION

Based on our activities, as described below, nothing has come to our attention to indicate that the Selected Information for 2025 is not fairly presented in the Report and the Website, in all material respects, in accordance with the reporting criteria.

## OUR ASSURANCE ACTIVITIES

Considering the level of assurance and our assessment of the risk of material misstatement of the Selected Information a multi-disciplinary team of sustainability and assurance specialists performed a range of procedures that included, but was not restricted to, the following:

- Evaluating the appropriateness of the reporting criteria for the Selected Information;
- Interviewing relevant staff to understand and evaluate the management systems and processes (including internal review and control processes) used for collecting and reporting the Selected Information;
- Reviewing of a sample of qualitative and quantitative evidence supporting the Selected Information at a corporate level;
- Performing an analytical review of the year-end data submitted by all locations included in the consolidated 2025 group data for the Selected Information which included testing the completeness and mathematical accuracy of conversions and calculations, and consolidation in line with the stated reporting boundary;
- Conducting two site visits to Weyerhaeuser facilities in Arcadia, LA [USA] and Drayton Valley, AB [Canada] to review source data and local reporting systems and controls;
- Performing in depth reviews of Southern Timberland's fertilizer application, controlled burning, and fuel use activities which included virtual interviews and thorough evaluations of data collection and consolidation methodologies, as well as assessments of reporting processes and detailed data reviews for completeness and accuracy;
- Evaluating the conversion factors, emission factors and assumptions used; and
- Reviewing the presentation of information relevant to the assurance scope in the Report and the Website to ensure consistency with our findings.
